

## 2017 - \$71,500 added Mixed Doubles Invitational (MDI) – Winner Take All Details:

The Mixed Doubles Invitational - Winner Take All is series of special events held at the TOC – with a total of \$71,500 added money - where players earn their invitation through Extreme-Team remote league and All-Star remote tournament participation.

**Types of Points and how to earn them** – Total points are tallied by multiplying league points by best three (3) remote tournament points to determine rank position. League points and tournament points described as follows:

- **League Points** – League match point values<sup>1</sup> increase progressively throughout the series-year to diminish disadvantage for new multi-league players who wish to compete for a Mixed Doubles Invite as well as a bonus value league points system in place to determine all rank list positions with bonus value added for designated leagues starting July 15, 2016:
  - 2 points per league match – July 15, 2016 – August 31, 2016
  - 4 points per league match – September 1, 2016 – October 31, 2016
  - 6 points per league match – November 1, 2016 – December 31, 2016
  - 8 points per league match – January 1, 2017 – February 28, 2017
  - 10 points per league match – March 1, 2017 – April 30, 2017
  - 12 points per league match – May 1, 2017 – July 14, 2017
  - 33% bonus point value added to designated capped and handicapped leagues starting July 15, 2016.

Note 1: League match values are scored at the value on the date of the scheduled match and may not be played ahead purely for increasing point rank position. **MATCHES MAY BE PLAYED AHEAD FOR OTHER REASONS.**

- **All-Star Tournament Points** – Points awarded based on finishing bracket position during each monthly All-Star Triples event. A minimum of three (3) remote tournament scores required to KEEP said points for point tally at end of season to determine rank list positions. Players with less than three (3) tournament points will have those points removed to determine finishing position of All-Star rank list on July 15, 2016.
- **Bonus Points** – Promoter bonus points<sup>2</sup> are additional points awarded to players who promote a specific to them league, in which they participate in, earn points as follows:
  - 6 teams – 6 bonus points
  - 7 teams – 7 bonus points
  - 8 teams – 8 bonus points
  - 9 teams – 9 bonus points
  - 10 teams – 12 bonus points

Note 2: Promoter bonus points have one-half of points awarded at beginning of league with the remaining half awarded at end of league – the remaining half is subject to change based on total teams participating at league end.

**How Invitations Are Determined** – Invitations are awarded to the Top 200\* of the All-Star rank list, ranked by most points earned through Extreme-Team remote league, bonus points and All-Star remote tournament play as found on the All-Star rank list on July 15, 2017. Eligible players strictly limited to fully sanctioned PPD members only.

The Top 200 of the All-Star rank is list sorted by SKILL LEVEL to determine whether a player gets a Gold, Silver or Bronze MDI. The top 32 players by skill earn a Gold invite, players 33-64 earn a Silver invite and players 65-96 earn Bronze invite<sup>3</sup>. [Click Here for MDI-Rank List.](#)

Note 3: To ensure that there are 96 eligible women for the 3 levels of the MDI – Winner Take All, eligible women players in the Silver and Bronze levels could exceed the top 200 on the All-Star rank list. For those women in the Top

200, players will be first sorted by skill levels. For women outside of the top 200, eligible players will be sorted by points. By way of example: there could be 54 women within the top 200 players and those 54 women will first be sorted by skill level with the highest 32 playing in the Gold and the remaining 22 playing in the Silver; then the remaining 10 women for the Silver, as well as the next 32 women for the Bronze will earn their spot within those events based on points. \*Top 200 OR 10% of the All-Star rank list, in excess of 2,000 players with 200 games or more.

**How to Register Your Invite** – An MDI icon appears on the All-Star rank list for all eligible players. Players contacted via PPD staff to ensure acceptance of invite. Pre-registration and pre-payment required. To register visit [www.dartstoc.com](http://www.dartstoc.com) then establish a “Player Account including profile”, then select the “register for tournament” icon. Registration is open August 1, through 4pm central time September 30<sup>th</sup> with initial TBD deadlines for players who fail to communicate on acceptance of invite.

Entry fee is \$100 per person + \$10 board fee at time of registration.

#### **When and Where –**

**Sunday – Oct. 15, 2017 – GOLD MDI - Winner Take All** - 9:00 am “forfeit time” – *payouts with \$55,000 added* – payouts based on 64 people (32 teams – triple elimination), paid to last place, as follows:

1 <sup>st</sup> -	\$50,000
2 <sup>nd</sup> -	\$5,000
3 <sup>rd</sup> – 32 <sup>nd</sup> -	\$200

**Monday – Oct. 16, 2017 – Silver MDI - Winner Take All** – 9:00 am “forfeit time” – *payouts with \$11,000 added* – payouts based on 64 people (32 teams – triple elimination), paid to last place, as follows:

1 <sup>st</sup> -	\$10,000
2 <sup>nd</sup> -	\$1,000
3 <sup>rd</sup> – 32 <sup>nd</sup> -	\$200

**Tuesday – Oct. 17, 2017 – Bronze MDI - Winner Take All** – 9:00 am “forfeit time” – *payouts with \$5,500 added* – payouts based on 64 people (32 teams – triple elimination), paid to last place, as follows:

1 <sup>st</sup> -	\$5,000
2 <sup>nd</sup> -	\$500
3 <sup>rd</sup> – 32 <sup>nd</sup> -	\$200

**How Partners Are Determined** – All players will draw<sup>4</sup> a chip for their partner during designated draw times as follows:

- Gold bracket drawings will be between 12pm – 2pm on Saturday, October 14<sup>th</sup>.
- Silver bracket drawings will be between 12pm – 2pm on Sunday, October 15<sup>th</sup>.
- Bronze bracket drawings will be between 12pm – 2pm on Monday, October 16<sup>th</sup>.

Note 4: Any registrant not in attendance by respective deadline will be drawn by PPD staff.

#### **IMPORTANT ONSITE SUBBING INFO –**

Onsite subbing should a registered MDI player fail to show will be done as follows –

If missing player is from the Gold level, the highest ranked Silver player will be allowed to sub in missing players spot AND retain their Silver position.

If missing player is from the Silver level, the highest ranked Bronze player will sub in the missing players spot and an onsite sub from the Bronze sub list will replace the player that moved to the Silver bracket.
