

2017 BullShooter Tour – Darts – TOC Qualifier Details - Updated: November 12, 2016



2017 BullShooter Tour sanctioning:

All 2016-2017 BullShooter Tour stops are sanctioned by the Partners Promoting Darts (PPD) sanctioning program. There are 12 BullShooter Regionals offered all across America for 2017 plus the Chicago Finals equaling 13 Tour stops in all.

At each 2017 BullShooter Tour Regional:

Sanctioned and eligible* PPD players may compete at each BullShooter Tour Regional stop for special 2017 Darts Tournament of Champions "Qualifier vouchers". The highest finishing man competing in the Men's Pro Singles and the highest finishing female in the Women's Singles Combo at each BullShooter Tour Regional stop will earn a Qualifier voucher to compete at the 2017 DARTS - TOC**. By way of example, the highest finishing PPD sanctioned/eligible man may finish in 2nd place. As the highest finishing male, he will earn a Qualifier voucher for the 2017 DARTS - TOC**.

At the 2017 BullShooter Finals in Chicago: The two highest finishing PPD sanctioned and eligible* men competing in the AA Men's Pro Singles 501 DI/DO or lacking two men in the AA Men's Pro Singles 501 DI/DO, the balance, if needed, will go to the highest finishing man or men in the Men's Pro Singles 501 DI/DO. And the two highest finishing women in the Women's Combo A/AA Luck of the draw will each earn a Qualifier voucher to compete at the 2017 DARTS - TOC**. By way of examples, there could be just one sanctioned and eligible* PPD man in the Men's AA Pro Singles 501 DI/DO. If so, he will earn a Qualifier voucher regardless of where he finishes and the remaining Qualifier voucher will go to the highest finishing man in the Pro Singles 501 DI/DO. If there are no sanctioned and eligible* PPD men in the AA Men's Pro Singles 501 DI/DO then both Qualifier vouchers will go to the highest finishing two men in the Men's Pro Singles 501 DI/DO. For another example, the highest finishing PPD sanctioned/eligible female player(s) may finish in 3rd place and 10th place on separate teams. Each will earn a Qualifier voucher. Or, two sanctioned/eligible female PPD players could draw each other (ON THE SAME TEAM) and finish higher than all other female PPD players, which would earn both women a Qualifier voucher. The two highest finishing females each earn a Qualifier voucher for the 2017 DARTS - TOC** whether on two teams or the same team.

* Player must be sanctioned by a PPD vendor and meet all PPD skill requirements at the time of the BullShooter event and must remain sanctioned by a PPD vendor and meet skill requirements through August 1, 2017 when their local PPD vendor will assign 2017 Qualifier vouchers. Players must remain in good standing with their local PPD vendor at all times. Please note all PPD standards are subject to local PPD vendor requirements that may be even more stringent than the national PPD requirements. Make sure to contact your local PPD vendor to ensure you meet all local PPD vendor requirements at all times.

** All Darts - TOC Qualifier vouchers are issued by local PPD vendor/members in these special BullShooter Tour Qualifier vouchers associated with this sanctioning. Extra Qualifier vouchers will be assigned to the respective PPD member/vendor's voucher "bank" on August 1, 2017 to facilitate issuance of the special BullShooter Tour DARTS - TOC Qualifier vouchers to the correct players.

Alternates also posted:

An alternate sanctioned and eligible* PPD player consisting of the next highest finishing player for each gender is listed on the standings page after each BullShooter Tour stop to indicate the player who may replace the player who was the highest finishing player at a BullShooter Tour Stop, should the original player fail to maintain eligibility as defined above and through August 1, 2017, the voucher issuance date.

Limited to one per player per tour-year:

BullShooter Tour DARTS - TOC Qualifier vouchers are limited to one per player per BullShooter Tour, although nothing in this rule is meant to infer that PPD players are limited to just one Qualifier voucher for the 2017 DARTS - TOC because players may earn multiple Qualifier vouchers through other local league and tournament activity as decided by individual and local PPD member/vendors across America.
