

June 2019 - \$15,000 added Cricket Singles Challenge (CSC)

What -

The Cricket Singles Challenges are invite-only gender specific tournaments, in which each round is played weekly. Total of \$15,000 in added money.

How –

Players earn an invitation through PPD Remote League Participation.

CSC Invitations are awarded to the highest-skilled (Player Rating) 32 men and 16 women ranked within the top 500 on the 2019 All-Star Rank list June 7th, 2019.

Registration –

Registration is \$100 per player. Must be registered by 6/20/2019.

Prior to registration, each player must have an established PPD User Account, W-9 filed & Player Bio filed.

To register: Visit your User Account, then select “Register for the Cricket Singles Challenge”. If you have not filled out your Player Bio, your name will NOT show up on the registration. Player Bio is required to participate in CSC.

When and Where –

CSC is a remote tournament played from each players’ local bar.

Men – Starting June 24, 2019 & runs every Monday at 8pm CST through August 26, 2019.

Women – Starting June 26, 2019 & runs every Wednesday at 8pm CST through August 14, 2019.

Payouts –

Men’s CSC payout is \$4,000 to 1st Place and payouts extend all the way to last place with \$100 paid to last place.

Women’s CSI payout is \$2,500 to 1st Place and payouts extend all the way to last place with \$100 paid to last place.

Format –

Men – Race to 11 Wins – ALL CRICKET

Women – Race to 9 Wins – ALL CRICKET

Double elimination bracket.

Cork for home team at the beginning of the match. After the first game, loser starts. If one team is down more than 2 games (3 games down or more), the match-trailing team will start until they are no longer more than two games down, at which time the match reverts to loser of previous games starts.

Board info –

Men – Choose “CORK” at the board. Corking is done prior to the first game & for a tiebreaker prior to the last game if teams are tied 10 - 10. The player found on the top of the match, as seen on the bracket is the home team and will cork first in all corking scenarios of a match. Corking a three-round game of 501 Open-in/Double-out with a Double-Bull. The player with the lowest 501 score after each player has thrown 3 darts, wins the cork.

“CSCM” is used for your cricket games. Choose CSCM at the board. The games will be set as “Players Choice” to start first so be sure the correct team is starting before starting the game.

Women – Choose “CORK” at the board. Corking is done prior to the first game & for a tiebreaker prior to the last game if teams are tied 8 - 8. The player found on the top of the match, as seen on the bracket is the home team and will cork first in all corking scenarios of a match. Corking a three-round game of 501 Open-in/Double-out with a Double-Bull. The player with the lowest 501 score after each player has thrown 3 darts, wins the cork.

“CSCW” is used for your cricket games. Choose CSCW at the board. The games will be set as “Players Choice” to start first so be sure the correct team is starting before starting the game.

All PPD Remote Tournament rules apply.

All participants must abide by the PPD Player Code of Conduct or penalties will be applied, starting with AT LEAST 90 day suspension for all PPD Tournament Activity.
